## Events for a Cause

In addition to the above, we've developed team building packages designed to make a difference. Packages start at £39 per person.

### Green Thumb Challenge

The Green Thumb Challenge is simple yet highly effective. As a team, guests are challenged with the task of coordinating, designing and completing a garden makeover. Equipped with gardening tools and basic raw materials, each team must plan, design and produce with the project parameters. The team needs to allocate time wisely, as they have a lot to accomplish. With plans to make and gardens to landscape, there is an activity for everyone.

### Community Center of Attention

Help beautify the island by giving one of our Community Centres a makeover. Perhaps work with local artists to design and reproduce a special mural for an exterior wall. You may also consider this for a children's home or other local community building,

### Team Teddy Bear

Team Teddy Bear is a unique way to bring you own team together while providing priceless comfort to local children in need. Participants divide into small work teams. Each group must complete a series of games/challenges to earn team points. The the final thirty minutes or so teams use their accumulated points to purchase all parts and accessories necessary to build a high-quality rescue bear.

### Build-A-Bike

Here's a team building activity that offers a rare opportunity to actually make a difference, with immediate, tangible results built into the process. Armed with wrenches and enthusiasm, your teams race to construct children's bicycles. Meanwhile other teammates are navigating fun, innovative puzzles and challenges to earn enough "money" for purchasing the last crucial part needed to make their team's bike the first off the line.

### Beach Olympics

Here's an opportunity to make a difference in the lives of local children and spend the afternoon of fun and games. Team captains, players and cheerleaders are chosen democratically and then the fun begins. We provide the props and the coaches and participants have the challenge of competing in an array of unique "Olympic" events (island style of course). A great way to complete the day and put a smile on the faces of our future stars and be able to present each child with a backpack filled with school supplies.

### Be A Good Sport

Spend the day of fun and games with some of our local children from any of the many children's homes. We can plan a children's party and game day at one of the national parks or sports grounds. Treat them to food, fun & games and a rousing cricket match and invest in a child's future in tangible and intangible ways.

### Social Responsibility Treasure Hunt

Engines roar, the flag drops allowing participants (four to a vehicle) to begin an exciting discovery adventure. Guests will be given a map or list of clues that when solved, take them along a pre-assigned route through the length and width of Nevis. It's a terrific way to see the island first hand and participants have the opportunity to interact with the locals. The participants will be given a list of items they must collect before returning to home base. All that is collected will then be donated to this charity for distribution to those who need it most.
